granting fitness certificate at anyone of the offices in Tamilnadu as per Rule 116 of Tamilnadu Motor
Vehicle Rules, 1989 by collecting necessary fees.

Sub: Motor Vehicles—TNHSP – 108 Emergency Ambulance Services – 385 Ambulance Vehicles on road- Fitness certificate to be issued by Regional Transport Officer's irrespective of registration – Instructions - issued –reg.

Ref: Letter No.3522/HSP/TN-EMRI/09 Dated:01.03.2010 received from the Special Secretary to Government Department of Health & Family Welfare and Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Project – DMS Building, Chennai – 6. Dated: 01.03.2010.

In the reference cited, it has been informed that the Government of Tamil Nadu is implementing emergency ambulance service by engaging Emergency Management Research Institute (EMRI) as ordered in the G.O.Ms.No.137 Health & Family Welfare Department dated: 05.05.08 Accordingly, 385 ambulances have been handed over to TN-EMRI and are currently operational in all the 32 districts.

It has been further stated that the Vehicles were registered at various districts in the names of the concerned Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and these ambulance Vehicles are now re-deployed by TN-EMRI to all over the state for providing emergency Medical care. Most of these vehicles are due for fitness check.

As such all Regional Transport Officer's in Tamil Nadu Stat are requested to entertain the applications for the issue of fitness of certificate or for the renewal of Fitness certificate as and when the vehicles are produced by the TN-EMRI irrespective of the place of registration subject to the following conditions.

1. Necessary applications forms with required Fee is duly paid.
2. Fee of Rs.75 + Rs. 50 (Service Charge) for each vehicle towards the permission for production of the vehicle at other office under rule 116 of Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicle Rule 1989.
