Sub: Motor Vehicles-Other State Omni Bus -Contract Carriages
plying on Temporary permit under section 88(8) – Misuse of
permit - action taken -Reg.

Kindly recall recent accident of an Air Conditioned Omni Bus near Vellore on
07.06.2011. Above vehicle was registered in Pondicherry. Vehicle at the time of accident was
operating from Chennai to Pollachi.

It is brought to the knowledge of this office that few Omni Bus Contract Carriages of
adjoining states are operated clandestinely within the state of Tamil Nadu based on the
temporary permit obtained from the original authority and paying taxes at Tamil Nadu on
weakly basis or monthly basis etc. This sort of operation is against the provisions of Motor
Vehicles Act, 1988. The special permits are usually issued under section 88(8) of Motor
Vehicles Act, 1988 to perform one round trip only, originating from the Home state and for
ending at home state itself. This provision is misused by some operators and such vehicles are
kept exclusively in Tamil Nadu itself and operated from point to point within the state, by
picking up and letting down passengers at various places.

Hence, all the Enforcement staff and Motor Vehicles Inspectors are hereby requested
not to allow such operation and such vehicles should be checked regularly. Any violation of
provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 should be booked and vehicle should be detained
under section 207 of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988.
